Encraftment Market Code of Practice for COVID-19

Policy for Encraftment Market to proceed/not proceed at COVID-19 Alert Levels:

Level 1 - Encraftment Market will proceed.

Level 2 - Encraftment Market will proceed at venues where stallholders number under 50, and will not proceed where stallholders number over 50.

Level 3 - Encraftment Market will not proceed.

Level 4 - Encraftment Market will not proceed.

MOH Guidance

The Encraftment Team will keep up to date with **COVID-19 Ministry of Health guidance**, making decisions and taking actions with regards to that guidance.

Contact Tracing

Stallholders and attendees will be required to sign in either using the NZ COVID Tracer App or by manually signing in on entry to our event. Any records held by Encraftment Market will be made available to the Ministry of Health should the need arise and will be held for a minimum period of 4 weeks.

Health of Stallholders and Attendees

Stallholders and attendees should only attend the market if they are feeling well and are free of COVID like symptoms.

On entry, please use hand sanitiser or wash your hands in the on-site bathrooms.

In accordance with the WorkSafe guidelines, the Encraftment Team will be checking in with stallholders on the day of the event to ensure that they are feeling well and have followed best hygiene practice for both themselves and their physical stall.

Encraftment Market, in conjunction with the venue, will ensure the hygiene of the overall venue, however, stallholders will be expected to ensure the hygiene of their own stall and personal hygiene, including mask wearing and providing their own mask if required.

Stallholders and attendees will be reminded (via email and social media) of best practice for safe gatherings before the event and encouraged to follow the guidelines set out.
